

The formation of the library's book collection is regulated by the laws of the Republic of Latvia (Library Law, KM Rules No. 416 / 25.09.2001) and the BIA Library Statute (25.08.2016).

The procurement budget is determined in proportion to the number of students and teachers who study and work in the program.

Library staff responsible for building the collection REGULARLY research the market and purchase books.

The collection of the library is created according to the study programs in the academy. **100%** of publications **in the Latvian language** relevant to the implemented programs are purchased both in the Central Library and in all Information and Service Points (ISP) in proportion to the number of students. Fundamental classical textbooks **in English** by reputable authors are procured, necessarily from the Central Library and if possible from the ISP. To a lesser extent, the collection is supplemented with valuable publications in Russian. Basically, they are translations of the most important world scientists and the works of prominent Russian scientists.

The creation of the BSA library collection is carried out in close cooperation with the leaders of the implemented curricula and teachers, based on the lists of required reading literature, as well as studying the supply and demand for books in the market. The number of books purchased is proportional to the number of students.

Donations from other universities and donations from private individuals also become an integral part of the collection.

Both teachers and students can offer the library to purchase new printed works and other documents.

The BIA library offers to use the list of sources when ordering, which shows links to the websites of Latvian and foreign publishing houses and bookstores, as well as the newsletter compiled by the National Library of Latvia "**Latvijas jaunākās grāmatas**" ("Newest books of Latvia")
